Creativity takes courage

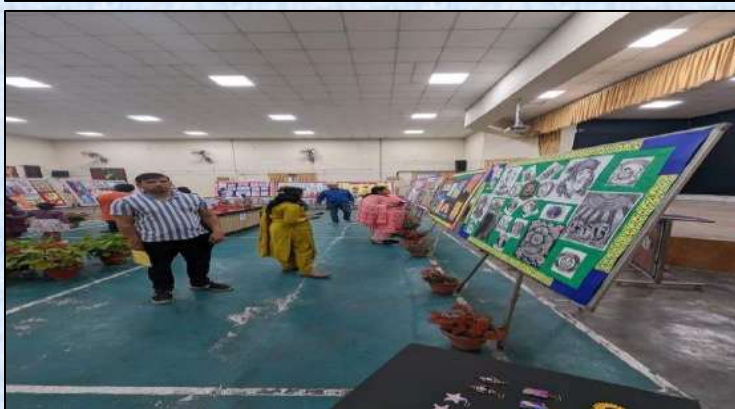

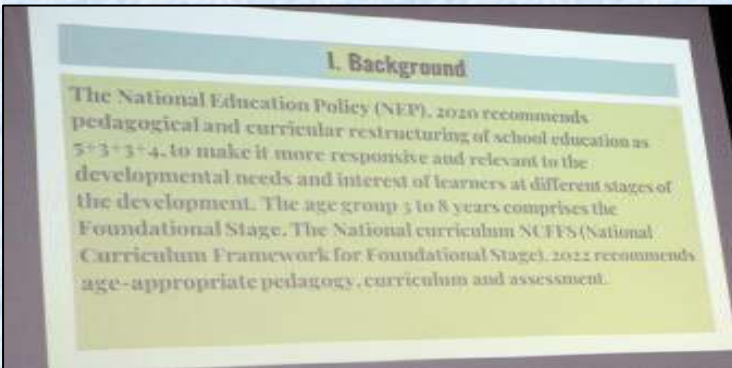
Pre-Primary Fun Sports Day

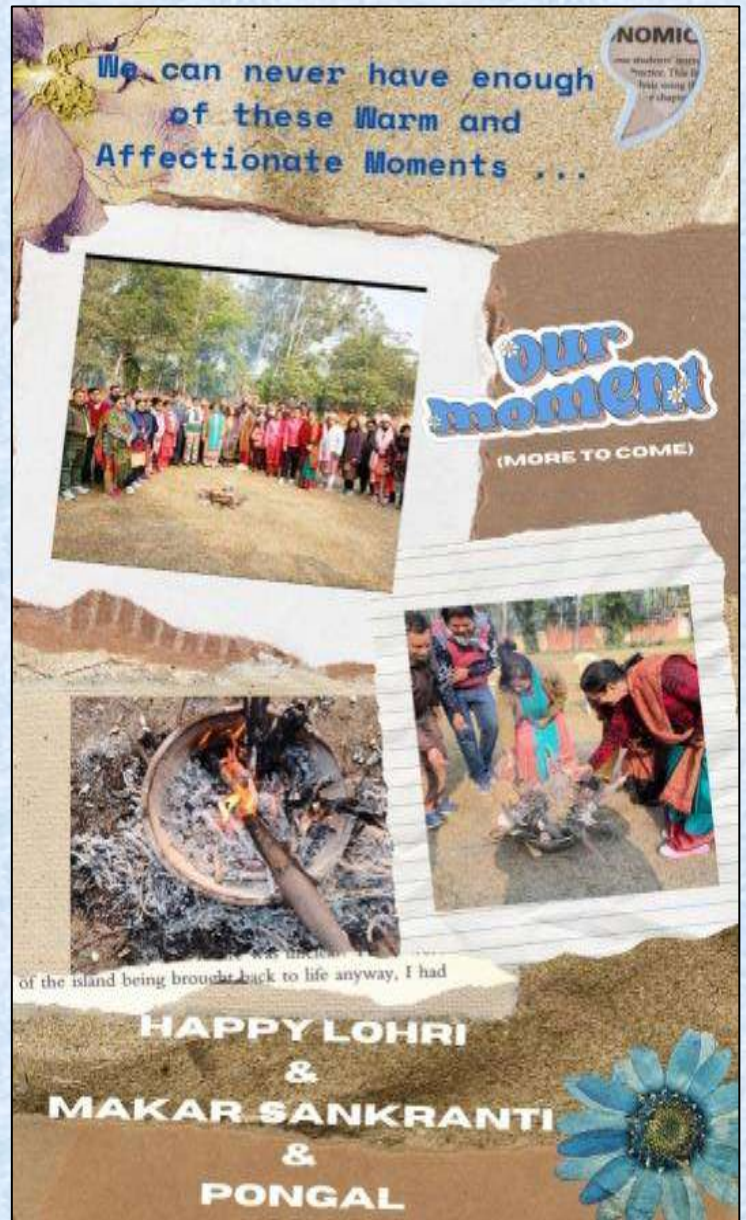




**Lohri, Makar Sankranti And Pongal Revelry:
