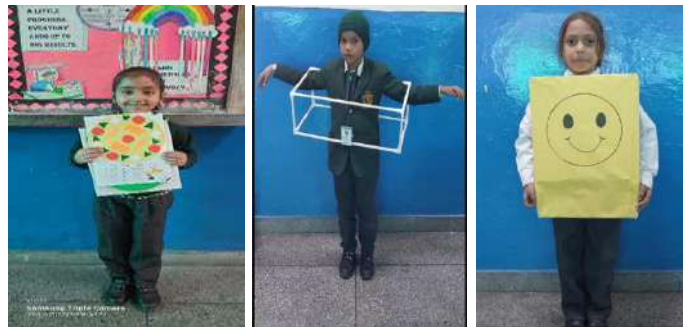

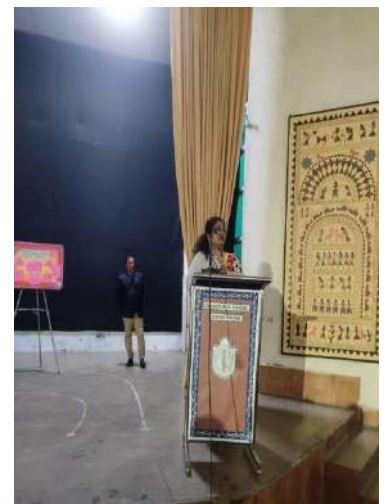
Role-Play (ClassesV-VIII-Dec. 20,2023)

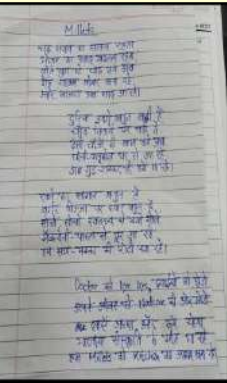

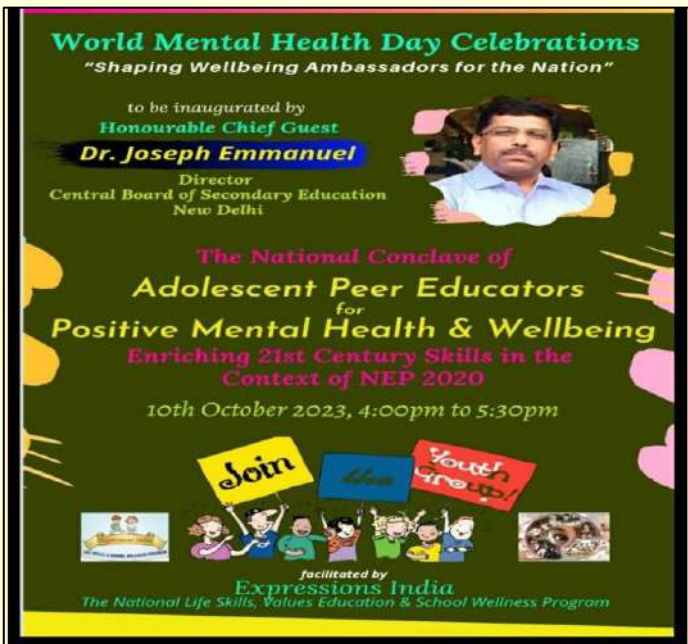

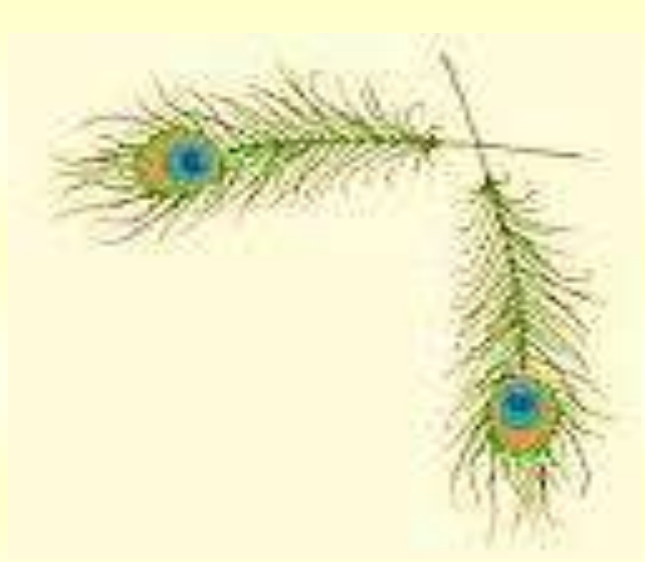
