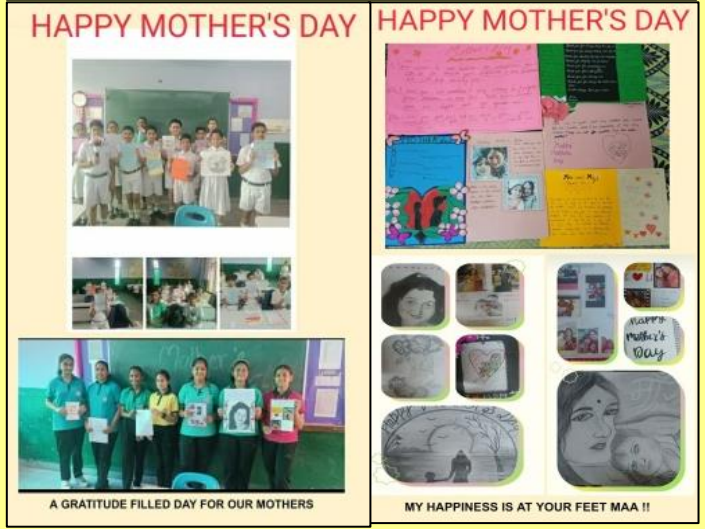

With an active, well trained and zealous group of felicitators the camp turned out to be tremendously a successful one.

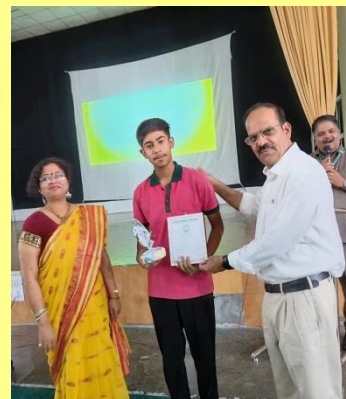


SESSION ON PERSONALITY DEVELOPMENT AND POSITIVE ATTITUDE

ADVERTISEMENT CAMPAIGN

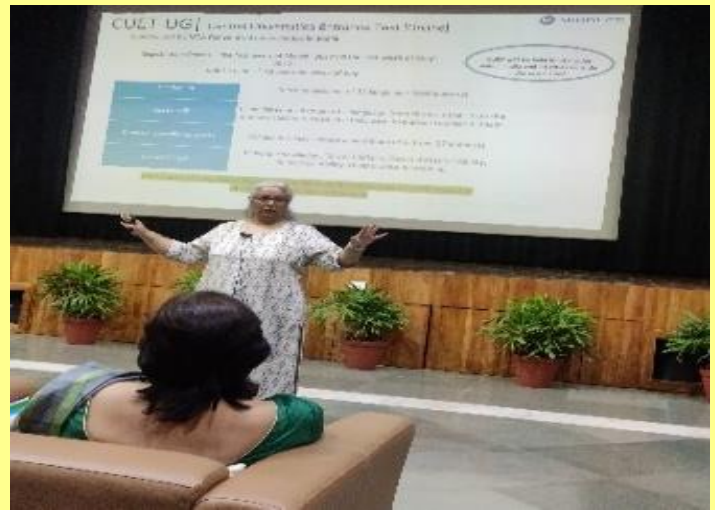

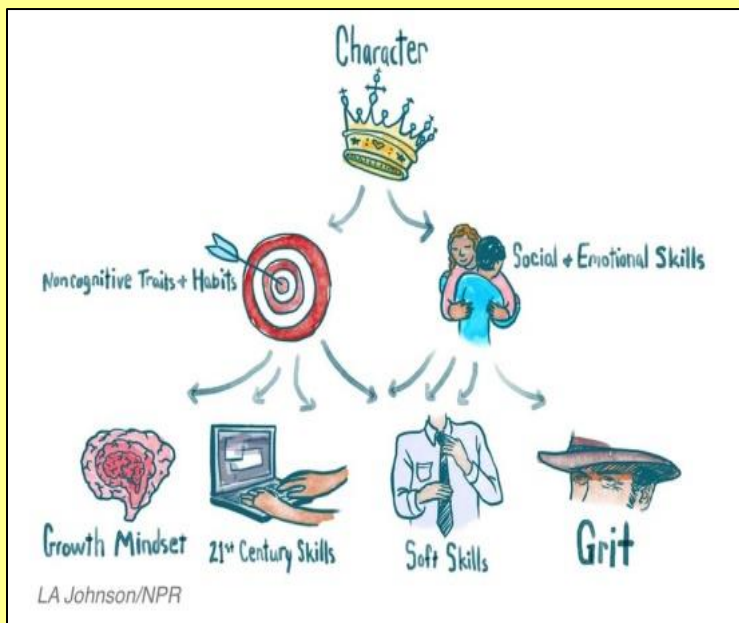
