INSTRUCTURED ASSESSMENT FOR ANALYZING LEARNING (SAFAL) is a competency-based assessment tool developed by the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) for students in grades 3, 5, and 8. It is designed to assess students' core concepts, application of knowledge, and higher-order thinking skills. The assessment will track schools' progress on core competencies in EVS/Science, Language and Mathematics in the school's language of instruction. DPS NTPC Vidyutnagar is a pilot school for the SAFAL program. The school has appointed two teachers, Mr. O.P. Singh and Mr. Ashish Choudhary, as Master Trainers for the program. These teachers will work closely with CBSE and the school students to understand their needs and provide necessary support and guidance.

THE YOUNG INNOVATOR COMPETITION": Atal Innovation Mission, NITI Aayog, New Delhi has partnered with Techfest IIT Bombay to organise "The Young Innovator Competition" aimed to encourage the students of classes V-X to think creatively and build innovative projects. WEBINARS

CHEMICAL EQUILIBRIUM- A webinar was hosted by HRDC DPS Society on November 11, 2022 which was attended by Sonia Tyagi, PGT Chemistry, DPS, Vidyut Nagar. The webinar dealt with Equilibrium which plays a key role in physical and chemical processes, including dynamic equilibrium in chemical processes, ionic equilibrium in solutions, and solubility equilibria of sparingly soluble salts. The law of chemical equilibrium and equilibrium constant govern the dynamic equilibrium, while various factors impact the overall equilibrium. Acids, bases, salts, ionization, and buffer solutions are important aspects in understanding ionic equilibrium

PROGRAMME IN ECONOMICS- Ms. Anshu Gupta, a PGT Economics teacher, attended a workshop at HRDC DPSS Knowledge Park V on November 17, 2022, led by renowned economists from NCERT, IIT Delhi, ISI Delhi, and Delhi University. Economics is concerned with making decisions about how to allocate limited resources among competing demands. As education is a high priority in allocating these resources, analysis of the returns of education, optimal resource allocation, and policy evaluation are increasingly important. Ms. Gupta shared her best practices for effective teaching, which included encouraging reading, implementing RWL (Read, Write, and Learn), establishing a resource center, and providing effective reinforcement and support for students who struggle.

EDUCATION FOR SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT

The aim of education is to foster Sustainable Development and the Handprint Care pedagogy plays a crucial role in achieving this goal. In India, CEE is piloting the Handprint Care pedagogy with teachers, principals, and educator trainers to promote the use of SDGs as a learning tool in the context of NEP 2020. 5 schools across the country was selected for this pilot project being organized by CEE Ahmedabad.

An international seminar on Education for Sustainable Development was organized by CEE at CEE Ahmedabad on 25th November, 2022 to discuss the relevance of Handprint Care pedagogy material and Educational resources in teaching concepts of Science and Social science in primary schools

DPSVN chose Water Conservation as its theme and was successfully led by Principal Poonam Dua. Ms. Ratna Samanta's satirical piece on water wastage initiated discussions on conservation, with Principal Dua emphasizing the importance of teaching children to value and use resources judiciously by turning off the school's electricity. She also stressed the role of policy makers in promoting environmental health through effective policies. Principal Poonam Dua emphasized the importance of giving teachers the freedom to choose their pedagogical materials.

The seminar on Handprint Care Pedagogy was held with a focus on promoting sustainable development through education. 
