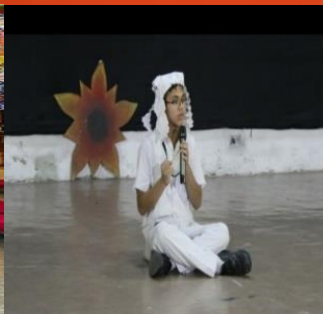

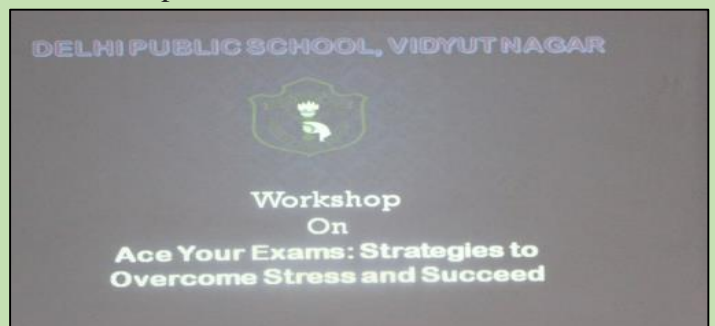

Inter-DPS Hindustani Vocal Music Festival

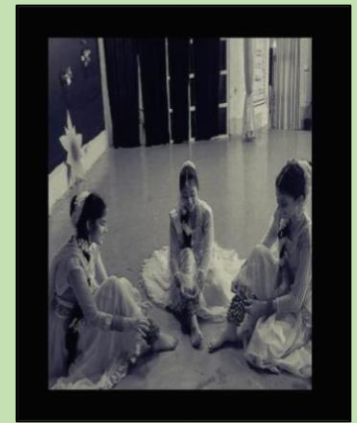

Guru Purnima

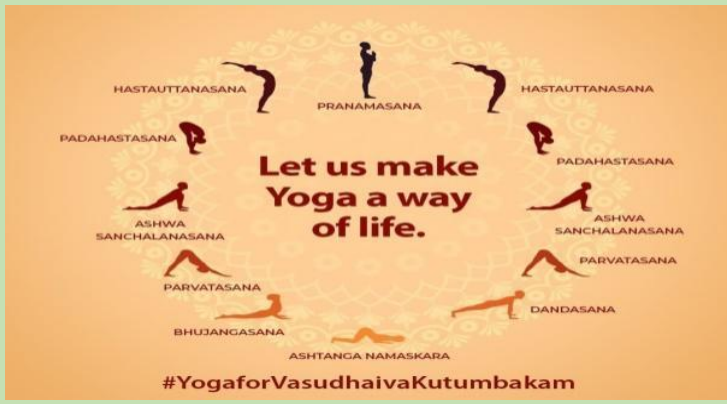
