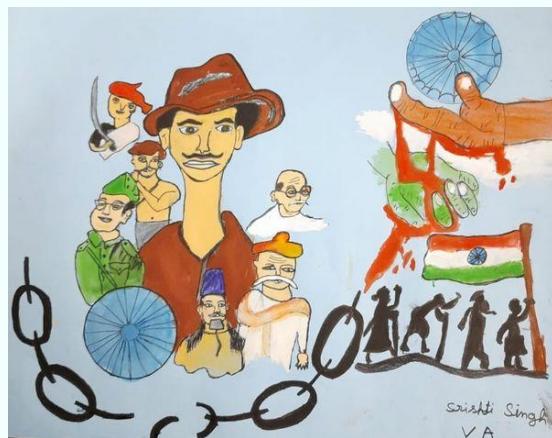

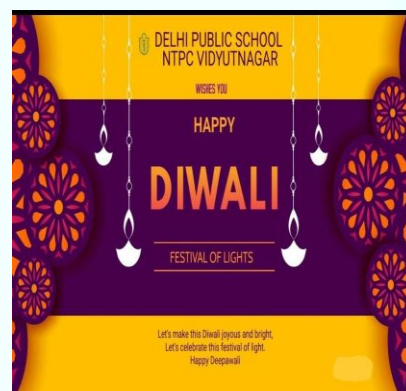
Children' Day Celebrations:
