Dear Readers



SPORTING GLORY: DPS VIDYUT NAGAR STUDENT HEADS TO STATE BASKETBALL CHAMPIONSHIP"

Principal Mrs. Poonam Dua attributed this remarkable success to the dedication of the students, the unwavering support of parents, and the tireless efforts of the teachers.




