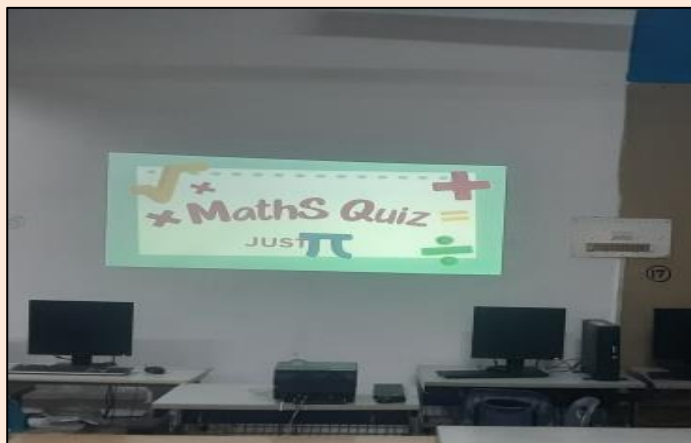
"JUST PI" MATHS QUIZ

Additionally, **Trisha Saha (5A)** will receive a consolation cash prize of ₹1500 for winning at the national level.

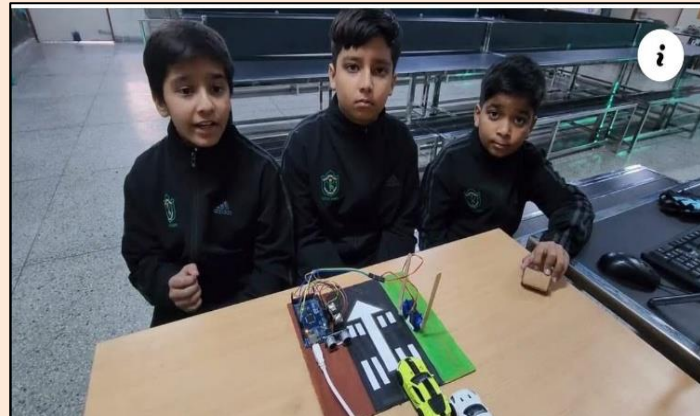


BUDDING ENTREPRENEURS

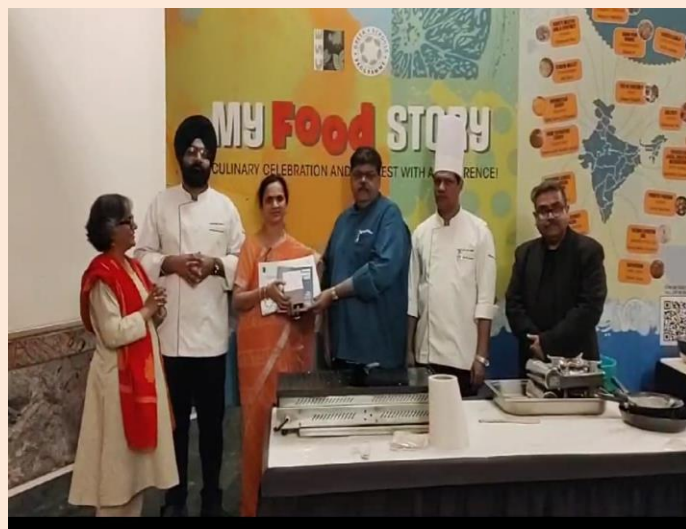

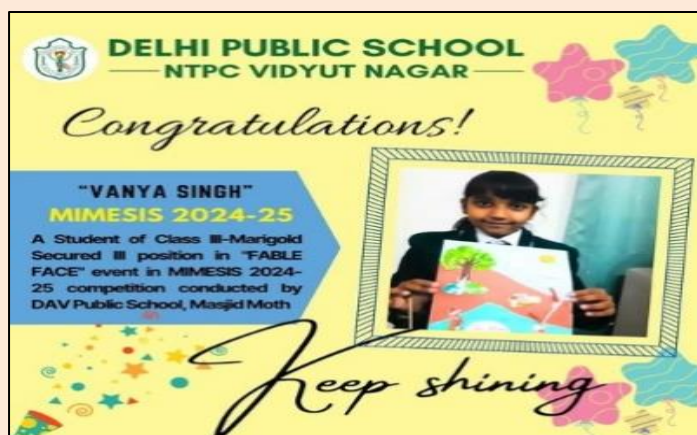
