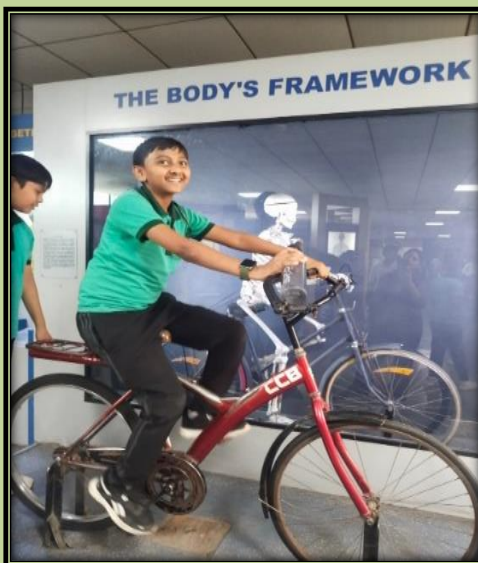

For Classes **IX and X**, an **Essay Writing Competition** was held on the topics New Education Policy and Language Learning.

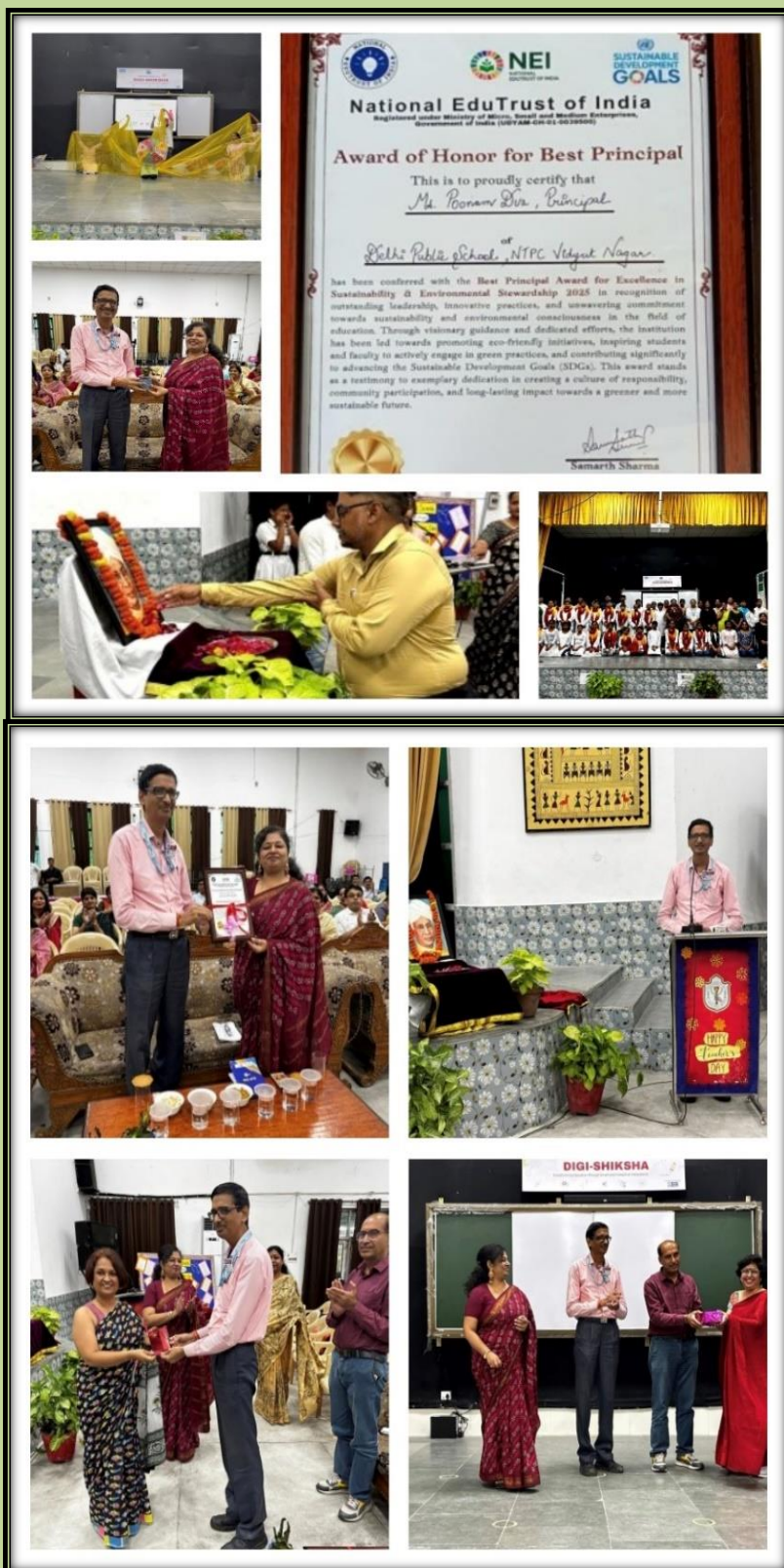

ATL Lab was set up in Delhi Public School in the Year 2018 under MoU with Atal Innovation Mission, NITI Aayog, New Delhi. Atal Innovation Mission (AIM) is Government of India's flagship initiative to set up Lab in schools to create and promote a culture of innovation and entrepreneurship across the length and breadth of our country in the early stage of life.

In this regard AIM regularly organizes different events for students to participate in **ATL Marathon, ATL Festivals, Mega ATL Tinkering Day, School Innovation Marathon, Young Innovator Competition** and other National and International Events.

AIM is associated with IIT Bombay and CBSE as the Government Partner to conduct a competition for school students. It is a Business-Plan Competition for school students from Classes 6th to 12th and Diploma promoting entrepreneurship at an early age. Eureka! Junior aims to flesh out creative and unique ideas to solve the problems of today. It encourages students' inquisitive minds to bring up innovative ideas and provide them with a platform to present their startup ideas.

Students of Class-VII, **Parth K, Piyush Choudhary, Gitansh Tomer and Harsh Sharma, Aarav Kashyap** from class-VIII and Tanya Ray of class-XI have been selected in the first round of the event.

In the second-round event they have completed their assigned task and are waiting for the next level. The final competition will be conducted at IIT Bombay in the Month of December.

AIM also associated with Ministry of Education (MoE) innovation cell to develop the culture of innovation and entrepreneurship in all India CBSE affiliated schools. The **Dipsites Gitansh Tomar, Harsh Sharma and Amad Salam** have been selected in **School Innovation Marathon-2024** among **1000 schools**. Atal Innovation Mission (AIM), NITI Aayog hosted 'Mega Tinkering Day' on 12th August 2025, India's largest-ever school-based tinkering event, bringing together students from schools across India. Held virtually and simultaneously in schools nationwide, the event saw participation of **4,73,350 students from 9467 ATL** equipped schools who engaged in a hands-on project to design and build a DIY vacuum cleaner, using everyday materials available in their labs. The activity was guided by a step-by-step instructional session streamed online, enabling students to learn scientific concepts and collaborate in real time no matter where they were. DPSVN received participation certificate.

My Inspiration Programme –

Delhi Public School, NTPC Vidyut Nagar organized the *My Inspiration Programme* for **Classes I–VII on 25th July and 28th August 2025**, providing parents with a platform to share their experiences and inspire students. Meditation Room- Nurturing the mental well-being

DPS VN has taken a progressive step toward nurturing the mental well-being of our students by setting up a dedicated Meditation Room. The serene space provides an opportunity for children to relax, refocus, and re-energize, ultimately supporting both their academic and emotional growth.

Weekly meditation sessions are conducted for all classes, ensuring age-appropriate practices:

Primary Students: Under the guidance of the School Counsellor, Ms. Tanya Verma, children are engaged in simple breathing exercises, guided imagery, and short mindfulness activities. These sessions have been highly effective in improving focus, calmness, emotional balance among young learners.

Middle School Students: Practiced walking meditation, progressive muscle relaxation, and mantra meditation are practiced to build concentration, reduce stress, and enhance self-awareness among the young teens.

Senior Secondary Students: Explored advanced practices such as Guided meditation, yoga meditation, and body scan meditation are practiced to equip the adolescents with coping strategies for exam stress, decision-making, and overall resilience.

Teacher Involvement—

An encouraging development is that subject teachers are also actively taking their classes to the **meditation room**. By integrating meditation into academic schedules, students are not only learning the subjects better but also experiencing enhanced attention, reduced **anxiety**, and **improved classroom participation**.

The introduction of meditation sessions has had a profoundly positive impact on students.



Regular practice has led to increased calmness and concentration in classrooms, allowing students to engage more effectively with the curriculum. Additionally, students have demonstrated improved emotional regulation, resulting in more positive peer interactions and a **harmonious learning** environment. Senior students, in particular, have benefited from better academic focus and stress management, helping them navigate the pressures of their studies. Notably, students eagerly anticipate **meditation sessions**, viewing them as a refreshing mental break that rejuvenates their minds and prepares them for further learning.

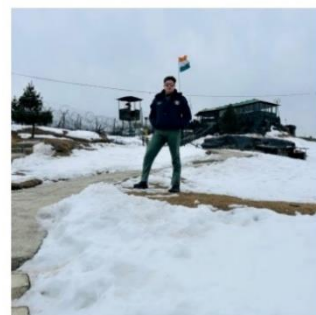
Mango Fest
