In conclusion, Rao Sir bestowed his blessings upon the school, wishing for its continued success and the attainment of even greater heights.

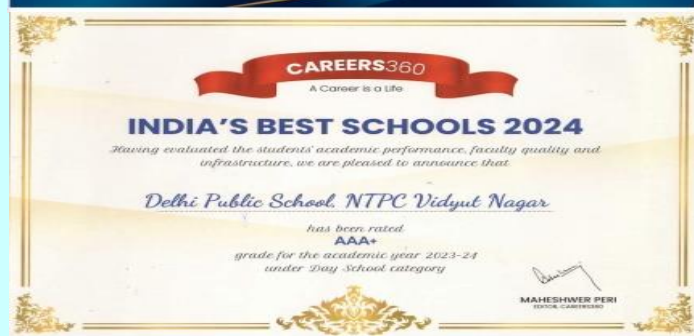
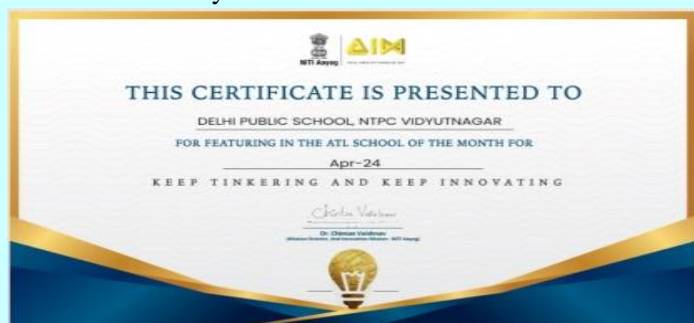

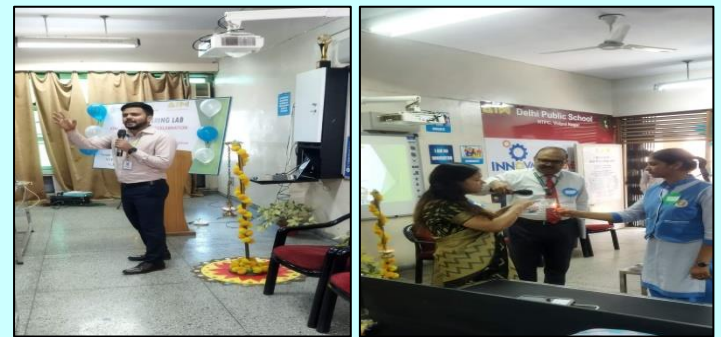


## EXCITING TIMES AHEAD!

**Art and Craft from Recycled Materials:** Attendees creatively utilized recycled materials to craft art pieces, showcasing the potential of upcycling.

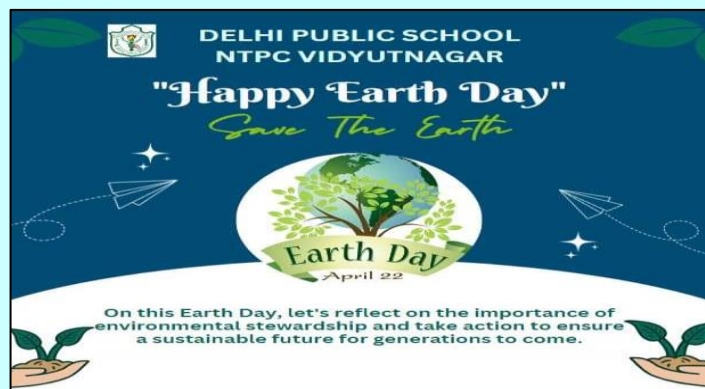
