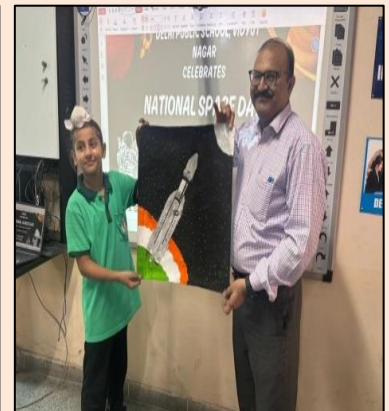


## NATIONAL SPACE DAY

Such assemblies play a vital role in providing holistic education, blending academics with cultural and moral learning of the students.



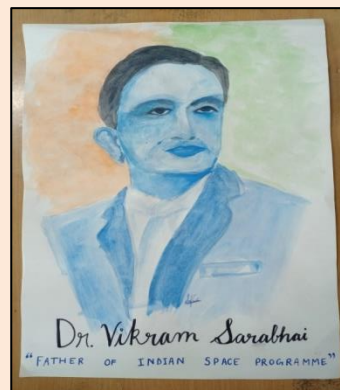
## RAKSHABANDHAN –SPECIAL

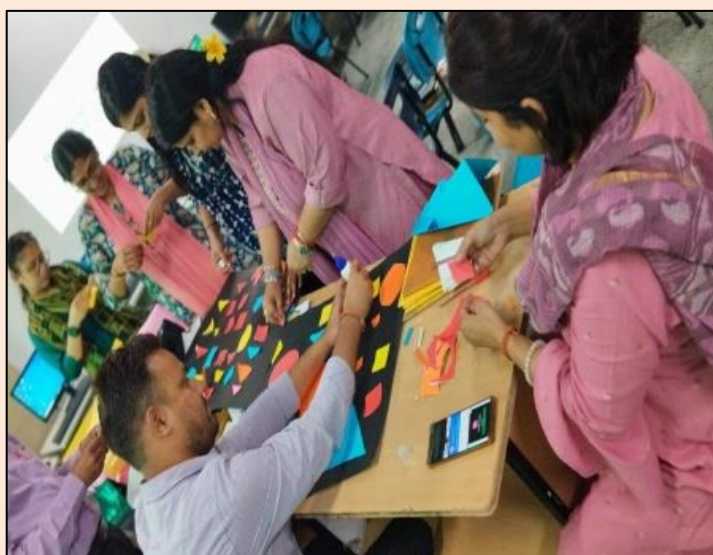
